Workshop One

Workshop Two

Morning	 Exploration of the stories that we would like to tell. Sharing our stories on food. Exploring how we may tell these stories onstage.
Afternoon	 Re-visit the wider research themes – Uneven Lines; Field to Table; Waste Not Want Not; A World in One City. Classification of stories into groups based upon research areas for project as a whole. Work as a group to agree the order of stories and who is going to tell what.
